

# Makakilo Quarry

## OUR PROPOSED PLAN AND THE BENEFITS TO HAWAI'I

**FOR NEARLY 50 YEARS**, the Makakilo Quarry has provided Hawai'i with stone to produce concrete, asphalt and other base materials to develop roads, highways and homes. Grace Pacific, a leading materials and construction company, owns and operates the Makakilo Quarry, one of only three operational quarries on O'ahu that serve the local community.

Located between the H-1 Freeway and Pu'u Makakilo, the quarry encompasses approximately 100 acres for rock extraction and processing, and nearly 300 acres of buffer zone to mitigate any impacts on neighboring properties.

## PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS

If approved by the City and County of Honolulu Planning Commission and the State of Hawai'i Land Use Commission, our proposed changes to Makakilo Quarry operations will yield significant benefits for Hawai'i and our economy through:

- 1** Ensuring the state has a reliable local source of rock needed for private and public construction projects for an additional 15 years beyond the current permit expiring in 2032
- 2** Production and sale of hot mix asphalt and concrete in the pit of the quarry at night in order to meet the construction industry's needs
- 3** An optimized quarry footprint that provides access to the best available rock at the site without adding acreage, while still providing a larger buffer between the quarry and surrounding neighborhoods
